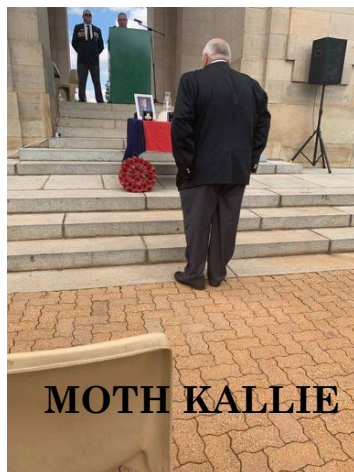
Hosted at the War museum in Saxonworld Johannesburg. Moths and Mothwa came together in celebration of MOTH 95.

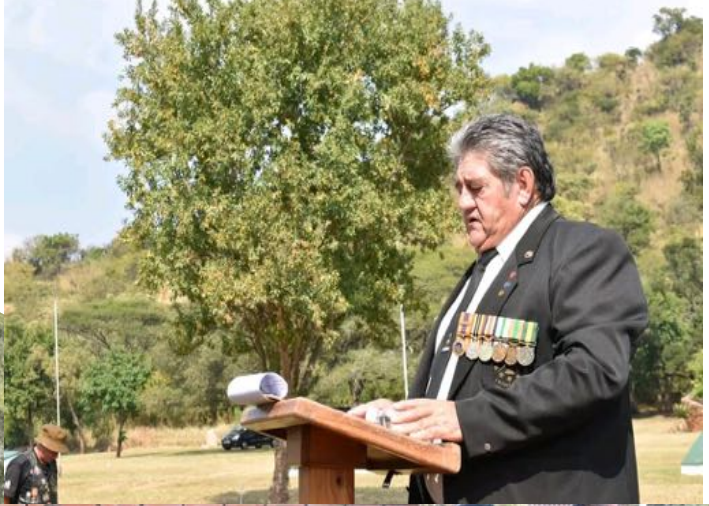

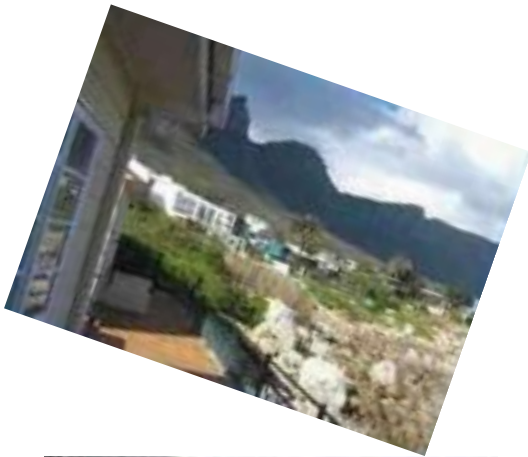
